Believe it or not, but you already know and use German in your everyday vocabulary. Just think of the number of foods that have German names.

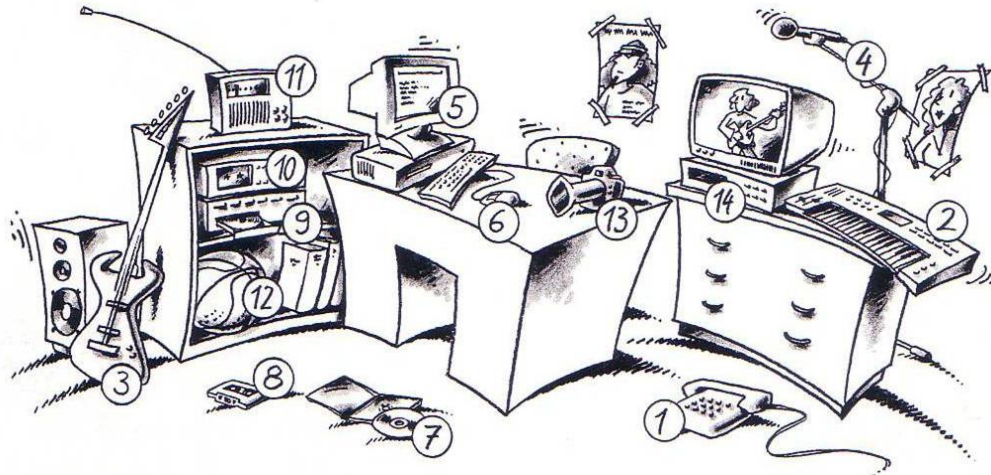
Below is a list of many German words that have worked their way into English. Can you think of any other words that might have been taken from German? List your ideas here.
